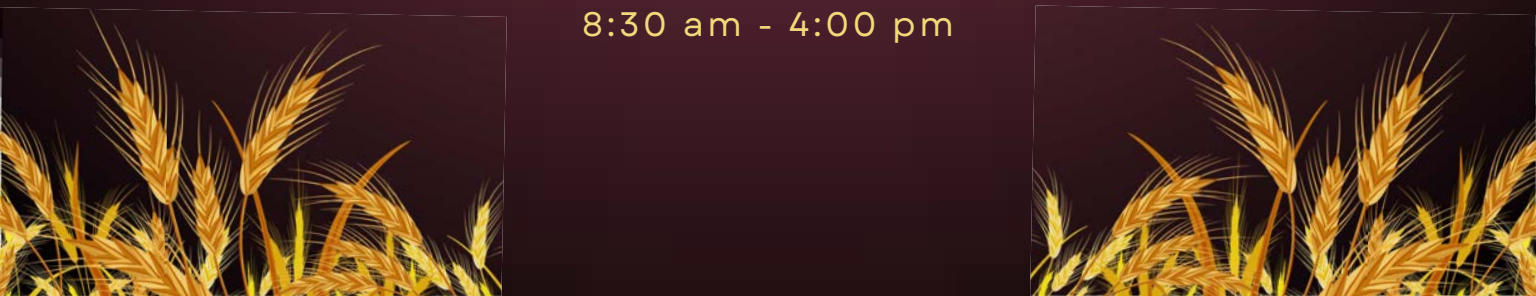

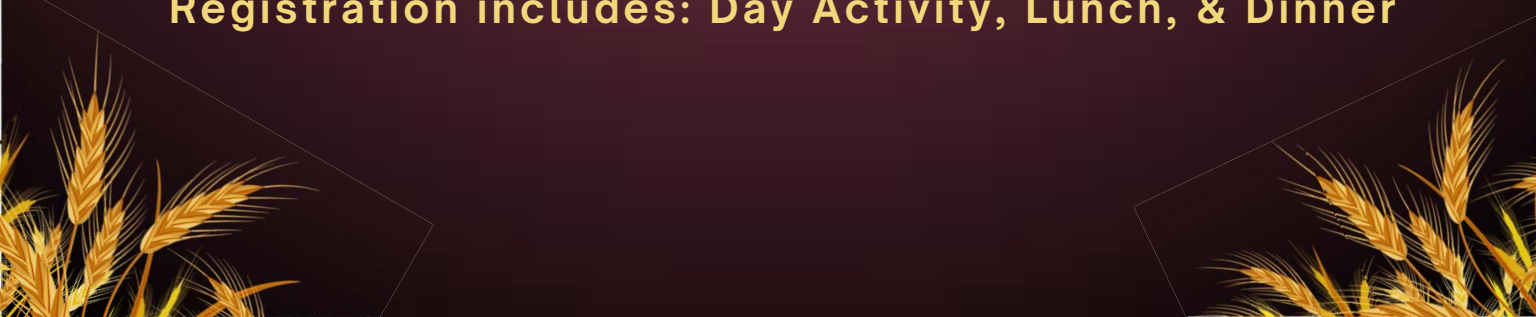

- As per JFAO policy, any members signing up on the day of the event will be charged an additional \$5.00 fee per person.
- Autumn Profile is an alcohol and cannabis free event, as per JFAO policy. The club of any participant found in possession of alcohol or cannabis will be subject to a fine of \$100.00 for a first offence and \$250.00 for a second offence.
